

The epidemic situation in Poland is worsening, which is why new restrictions were introduced, which entered into force on March 20 to April 9.

## From March 20 to April 9, the following arguments will apply throughout Poland. Suspend your activities:

 hotels (with the exception of, inter alia, workers' hotels, as well as accommodation provided as part of travel services - the exact catalog of exceptions along with the required confirmation of a business trip will be included in the regulation);

- shopping malls with the exception of, inter alia: grocery stores, pharmacies and drugstores, press salons, bookstores, pet stores and DIY stores. In shopping malls, there are still full-length activities, incl. hairdressing, optics, banking, laundry services;
- theaters, museums, art galleries (coverage is sampled and practiced as well as online events);
- cinemas (screenings of films also apply to cultural centers and centers);
- swimming pools (except for swimming pools in entities performing medical activity and for members of the national team);
- saunas, solariums, Turkish baths, slimming salons, casinos;
- ski slopes;
- fitness clubs and gyms;
- sports facilities (may only be used for entertainment and not involving the public).

For safety reasons, all students in Poland - including grades 1-3 - will learn remotely. Nationwide and also online access - wherever possible.
